## Legend:

- 1 Building plan for “Or Sameakh” Yeshiva (Tenenbaum Centre) (Building plan 68858) – State confiscation of Palestinian land in 1968. Evidently given to the Yeshiva without a tender. The plan was approved for deposit on 16/7/2017
- 2 Plan for demolition of a house and building of a 6-story building for offices (Building plan 499699) – **Released Property\***. The Palestinian family was evicted in 2008 after an eviction suit by the Jewish legal successors. The plan was approved for deposit on 16/7/2017.
- 3 Plan for demolition of a building and construction of 10 housing units in 5 floors (Building plan 14029) - **Released Property\***. 5 Palestinian families live in the building as protected tenants. The plan was approved for deposit on 16/7/2017.
- 4 Plan for demolition of a building and construction of 3 housing units on three floors (Building plan 14151) – **Released Property\***. 3 Palestinian families live in the building as protected tenants. The plan was approved for deposit on 16/7/2017.
- 5 Released Property\*. In 1987, the court ordered the eviction of a Palestinian family following the eviction suit by the Jewish legal successors. The process of the execution office has started.
- 6 Released Property\*. Settlers demanded the eviction of the family, and the court ordered the eviction. The execution office gave an eviction order for 9/8/2017.
- 7 Property run by the General Custodian\*\* - the General Custodian demanded the eviction of the family on the grounds of not renewing the lease, and the court ordered their eviction, without the family knowing of the suit and having the opportunity to make their claims. The execution office gave an eviction order for 22/10/2017.
- 8 Residential building, library and coffee shop that are partially Released Property\* and partially run by the General Custodian\*\* - Settlers demanded the eviction of the family from their part of the property. The case is pending in the Magistrates Court.
- 9 Released Property\*. Settlers demanded the eviction of the family, and the court ordered that the eviction of the family from parts of the apartment will take place soon.
- 10 Run by the General Custodian\*\* - after a threat of eviction by the General Custodian, the lease was extended to 9 more years, out of which three have past. Lately the General Custodian increased the rent by 50%.
- 11 Released Property\* - Settlers moved into the house in 2009 after the Palestinian protected tenant past away.
- 12 Released Property\* - Settlers sued the family. In August 2009, the family was forcibly evicted from their home and settlers moved in.
- 13 Released Property\* - Settlers sued the family. In August 2009, the family was forcibly evicted from their home and settlers moved in.
- 14 Released Property\* - Settlers sued the family. In 2009 the family was forcibly evicted from part of the house and settlers moved in.

\* **Released Property** – property that was owned by Jews before 1948 and is today in the hands of the legal successors of the property or settlers who bought their rights. After 1948 the property was run by the Jordanian Custodian for Enemy Property who leased it to the Palestinian residents. After 1967 the Israeli General Custodian received handling rights of the property and continued to lease it to the Palestinian residents. Following a request from the legal successors of the original Jewish owners, the property was released to their hands and they became owners.

\*\* **Run by the General Custodian** - Property that was owned by Jews before 1948, and after 1948 was administered by the Jordanian Custodian for Enemy Property who leased it to the Palestinian residents. After 1967 the Israeli General Custodian received handling rights of the property and continued to lease it to the Palestinian residents to this day.
